



Trinity Lutheran Early Childhood Center Medical Policy

- Trinity Lutheran Early Childhood Center maintains compliance with New York State requirements for health exams and immunizations.
- Records of physical examination and immunizations are required for all new and returning Trinity Early Childhood Center students.
- Physical examination forms and notifications of immunization requirements will be provided to families annually. Students will not be permitted to attend school if proof of examinations and immunizations are not submitted when required.
- Please let the ECC Director know of anything concerning the general health of your child, such as vision or hearing problems, allergies, etc. All injuries whether sustained in or out of school should be brought to the attention of the ECC Director and the teacher.
- The ECC Director or teacher will notify a parent in instances of illness or injury to a student. Our facilities cannot accommodate extended care of a child. Parents must arrange for the child to be picked up promptly.
- Parents will be notified in writing of any contagious condition occurring among their child's school population.
- Medication cannot be administered in Trinity's Early Childhood Center.
